

YEAR IN REVIEW

Fiscal year 2022 brought many exciting changes, programs, and events to Ravenwood.

Four new programs started this year: a Clubhouse for adults with severe and persistent mental illness, a 988 hotline, a Poverty Collaborative, and a Care Management entity.

The Clubhouse is a unique service where members run this fantastic program and can participate in various activities, including supported employment, adult day treatment, and social and recreational activities.

Ravenwood Health was chosen as the 988 national suicide hotline providers for Geauga County.

We were excited to be a part of the national program.

Through a United Way grant, seven agencies in Geauga County joined together to establish a Poverty Collaborative. Representatives from each agency meet biweekly to review individual situations, hear case presentations, make referrals, and fund some services to help those in need obtain and maintain financial stability.

Aetna awarded Ravenwood the Care Management Entity Contract for Northeast Ohio. Along with partner agencies, Crossroads Health, Community Counseling Center, and New Directions, the program provides Care Coordination for children with behavioral health concerns in Geauga, Lake, Ashtabula, and eastern Cuyahoga counties.

We held two unique and successful fundraising events. Our annual Anthony Donofrio event was fun, with 100 hundred golfers, and many volunteers. The proceeds fund substance abuse treatment for those who otherwise could not afford it. A huge thank you to the wonderful Donofrio Family and their friends!

Our second fundraiser was an Amish Dinner and Raffle. Our speaker was an Amish woman who shared her recovery journey. It was a powerful and moving presentation. The proceeds help fund services for the Amish community.
